



BLADENSBURG NATIONAL PARK HALF DAY TOUR

One of the original sheep stations in the Winton region, Bladensburg National Park is steeped in history but also has the rugged beauty of rock formations and diverse flora and fauna. Wander through the shearing shed and old homestead buildings before travelling across blacksoil plains and clays to marvel at the natural rock formations of the Scrammy Jump-up. The Scrammy Gorge is a fabulous example of erosion undermining the harder rock, while further up the creek the permanent waterhole is a pleasant spot for a cup of tea. We'll then take in the spectacular view from Scrammy Lookout before returning to town.
